Nominations Being Accepted for Parish Trustee-Treasurer

According to the Wisconsin State Statute regarding Parish Corporate Bylaws, each parish must hold a public election for the position of trustee. Parishioners are allowed to nominate candidates who, if elected, will be a legal member of the parish corporation along with Fr. Jim and Terri Newbury. Jim Schuster currently holds this position and has expressed a willingness to be nominated for another term. Other candidates must be a practicing parish member, at least 25 years old, and be nominated in writing by at least 10 active parishioners by Tuesday, October 29th. The letter should include a few sentences about why he/she would be a good trustee. On November 2-3 the nominees will be announced. On November 9-10 the election will take place during Mass.
