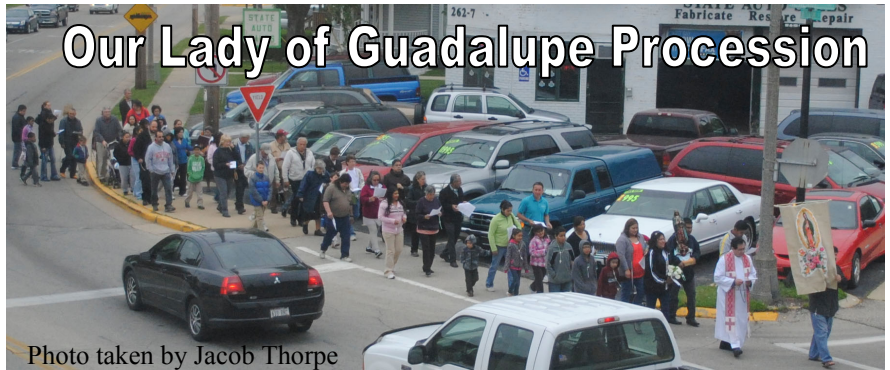

This photo was taken on May 25th during a procession organized by the Hispanic Community at St. Charles, who invited the Burlington Catholic Community to attend. All three parishes were represented along with the Franciscan Missions in Rochester, the newly established Knights of Columbus Council 15665 (Chartered March 19th, 2013 at Immaculate Conception - St Mary Church), and the Daughters of Isabella.



Fr. Sergio Lizama led the procession, he works with the Hispanic Ministry Burlington and the area. Fr. Sergio encouraged everyone in attendance to start planning for a grand Eucharistic Procession for Corpus Christi 2014 involving the entire Burlington Catholic Community. Fr. Jim Volkert supported Fr. Sergio's challenge.

The History of the Hispanic Ministry in Burlington began on July 20, 1999, when two sister's, Sr. Emma Teresa Nunez from Bolivia and Sr. Graciela Paredes from Ecuador, came to Burlington and began to work with the Hispanic people. Their Community's name is "Missionary Franciscan Sisters of the Youth" which was Founded in Ecuador by Msgr. Fausto Travez, OFM, who is now Archbishop to Quito Ecuador. There are now four Sister's who live in St. Charles Rectory.
