## SYNOD TOPIC: EVANGELIZATION: The Faithful Discern Marriage/Family Priorities

Below are the top two priorities in Marriage and Family voted on at the Synod.

**1st – 30% – Building Catholic Families Campaign:** Implement a “Building Catholic Families” campaign that includes practical, user-friendly strategies for families to strength and practice their Catholic identity in a culture of “busyness” and family disintegration.

**2nd – 18% – Support for Engaged and Married:** Implement new, creative and effective strategies that provide support at the parish and archdiocesan levels for engaged and married couples.

Other areas of marriage and family such as formation on the human person, evangelization on annulments and marriage definition initiatives were discussed and discerned, and will be taken into consideration as Archbishop ListECKI creates his Synodal Declaration.
