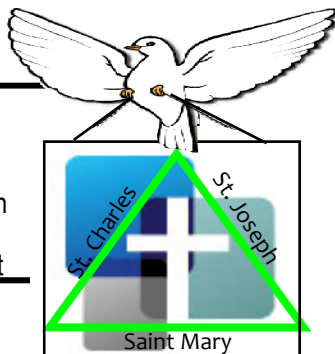

Before the election takes place registered parishioners are allowed to nominate candidates for the position. Therefore, I am opening the nomination process for the position of **Parish Trustee - Secretary**. This person, along with Jim Schuster will be a legal member of the parish corporation. Terri Newbury, who currently holds this position, has expressed a willingness to be nominated for another term. Other candidates must be a practicing parish member and at least 25 years old. As pastor, I am allowed to nominate a candidate. Additional candidates must be nominated in writing by at least 10 active parishioners and submitted to me by Nov. 15. This letter should include a few sentences about why he/she would be a good trustee. On Nov. 19-20 the names will be announced and on Nov. 26-27 the election will be held during Masses.

## Volunteer Now to Light the Advent Wreath

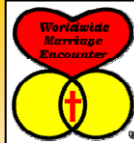
